Propositions

14: NO (Issues \$5.5 billion in bonds for state stem cell research institute)

15: NO (Requires commercial and industrial properties to be taxed based on market value despite county assessor who says it cannot be implemented)

16: NO (Reintroduces racial discrimination in public employment, education or contracting ACA5)

17: NO (Gives the right to vote to people convicted of felonies who are on parole.)

18: NO (Lower voting age – **Allows 17 year olds - 18 by the next general election - to vote**)

19: NO (Increases property assessments on certain property intergenerational transfers where beneficiaries do not reside on the property)

20: YES (Re-authorizes felony sentences for certain offenses currently treated as **misdemeanors**)

21: NO (Expands local governments' authority to enact rent control on residential property)

22: YES (Considers app-based drivers to be independent contractors, enacts industry-specific labor policies including minimum, compensation, health care subsidies and background checks)

23: NO (Authorizes State Regulation of Kidney Dialysis Clinics. It establishes minimum staffing physician on site, consent from the state for a clinic to close and other requirements.)

24: NO (Creates new state agency overseeing, penalizing businesses for using your personal information , sounds good but expands government intrusion)

25: NO (Referendum to overturn the law that replaced the privately run bail system with a government run risk assessment of current system for suspects awaiting trial)

Los Angeles County Measures

Measure **J** **NO** (Significantly **defunds law enforcement services**)

MAKE YOUR VOTE COUNT Put your mail-in ballot in a safe place.

As you are probably aware, your ballot can be lost, stolen, trashed or used illegally by one of the many people with access to it. Votes tallied in the vote center can prevent that.
